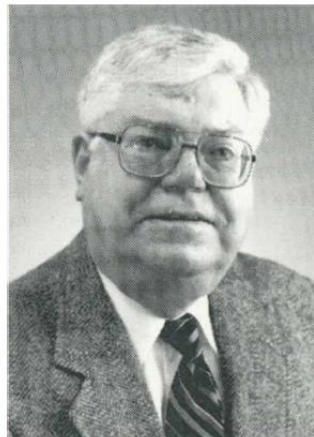
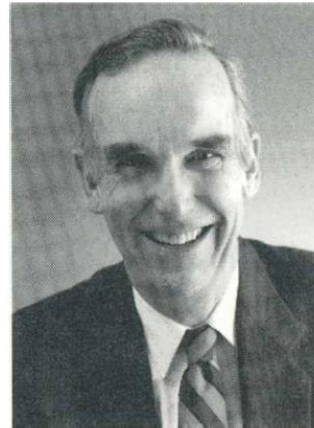

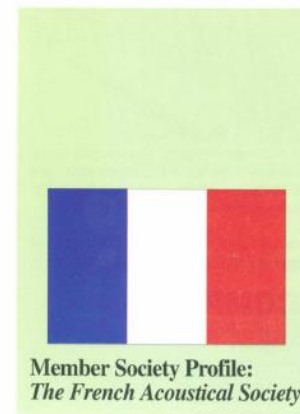
The Launch of a New International Publication

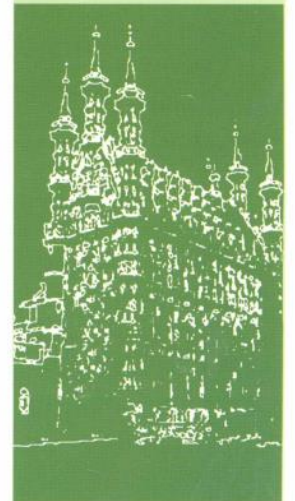
